WHEREAS, the Village of Tully intends to submit a joint application to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation and United States Army Corp of Engineers for a stream cleaning permit, as more specifically described in the SEQRA EAF part 1 completed in connection herewith and incorporated herein ("Project"); and **WHEREAS**, said permit is for the removal of gravel bars and sediment in the stream bed for proper drainage along the Village's wastewater treatment plant premises, bridges and STP discharge area, as well as to alleviate drainage issues throughout the entire Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board having reviewed the EAF part one, and having been presented with a project overview by Village Engineer, Kenneth Teter, and having been advised by the Village Attorney that same qualifies as a Type II action under SEQRA;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- 1. The Village of Tully hereby determines under 6 NYCRR 617.5 (c), the action as described in the EAF part 1 is a Type II action requiring no further review under SEQRA; and
- 2. The Village's Superintendent of the Department of Public Works and/or Village Engineer is hereby authorized to submit the necessary application and supplemental documentation as required in order to secure the permit, and to execute and the application to the applicable agency(ies);

Upon motion made by Mayor Melissa Flint-Morgan, and seconded by Trustee Roxanne Oliver, the foregoing resolution was put to a roll call, which resulted as follows:
