WWTP Controller Upgrade Project: All of the installation and training work is now completed. As such, I am recommending approval and payment of Pay Appl #4 for \$18,813.48. Both Ruth and Tom have the electronic copies and the approved hard copies are in the mail for signature by Erin once they arrive. If you could please pass a resolution to approve the Pay App #4, that would be great. We are now awaiting the final documentation (manuals, etc.) and closeout documents and once we review and approve them, we will be recommending payment of the remaining 5% retainage (approximately \$5,500.00).

Upon motion by Trustee Vernay, 2nd by Trustee Oliver it was unanimous to approve Pay App #4 for \$18,813.48 for the WWTP controller upgrade. All ayes carried.

Counsel:

No report

DPW:

The board has authorized Kevin to obtain 3 quotes for a "chopper pump" for the remote lift station. This is due to the Circle K, Kinneys and the Hotel of throwing unauthorize substances into the sewer system. This has resulted in major expenses to the Village in the way of overtime, renting of extra equipment and excessive time spent on the issue during normal business hours.

Chipper: The chopper has just been delivered. Training will being next week. The invoice will be submitted to the board for payment once training is complete.

Blower: Kevin has received quotes but one does not include info on prevailing wages. He will contact them again or obtain a quote from another vendor.

Flags: quotes for replacement American Flags \$587.00 Display Sales

And \$663.44 Carrot top

Upon motion by Mayor Goodfellow, 2nd by Trustee Bibik it was unanimous to go with Display Sales for \$587.00.

Fire Extinguishers: replacement extinguishers quotes: Jerome \$1,016.28 Riverside \$1,659.95. Upon motion by Trustee Oliver, 2nd by Trustee Vernay it was unanimous to go with Jerome for \$1,016.28.

Upon motion by Trustee Vernay, 2nd by Trustee Bibik it was unanimous to authorize Suit-Kote to apply cracked sealing as needed through the Village for up to \$4,000.00. All ayes carried.

The street sweeper is up and running. Maintenance continues on other machinery.

Mike is taking a course at W2O to obtain D certification.

Trustee Vernay has quotes from W2O and Camden. W2O \$750.00 Camden \$1,000.00 plus \$95.00/trip Upon motion by Trustee Vernay, 2nd by Trustee Bibik it was unanimous to authorize the Mayor to sign a contract with W2O for \$750.00 to cover the WWTP until Mike receives his certification class D in water.

CODES:

The Village will start with Ralph, in regards to the issues with Circle K, Kinney, and the Hotel. The Mayor will also have Courtney write a letter stating our concerns over the abuse of the sewer system.

There are also garbage issues at 42 Elm Street. The Board will have Ralph write a letter and visit them.

Climate Smart Update:

The Village has reached the level of Bronze Climate Smart Community through its upgrades. The \$10,000.00 grant received with this honor will be applied to installation of a heat pump in the WWTP office plus some electric lawnmowing machinery. The Village is only 300 points away from earning a Clean Energy Community grant. The options for earning that grant include having a community campaign for electric vehicles and one for heat pump installations.

Comprehensive Plan Update:

Barton & Logidice presented their plan to the public. The public was allowed to make comments, recommendations and preferences. There will be another meeting in May. Please contact the Town or Village office for date and time.

Public Comment

The Village will install a new Stop sign at Grove Street at their earliest opportunity.

Eric Galvin from the ZBA is requesting training. Mayor will contact Courtney about coming and conducting a class for zoning and planning board members.

Upon motion by Trustee Bibik, 2nd by Trustee Ray it was unanimous to authorize the village to spend up to \$900.00 to set up email and hosting for the Village.

Audit Bills

Upon motion by Trustee Vernay, 2nd by Trustee Oliver, it was unanimous to review and authorize the accountant to pay the bills, subject to audit.
