Mayor Goodfellow led the Pledge of Allegiance and called the meeting to order at 2:01pm.

Representatives from MRB presented the board with the 4 Bids that came in for WWTP Influent Pump Station Improvements Project. They will further review the bids at their office and recommend on January 8, 2025 what Bid they feel is the best choice for the Village of Tully. The four bids are as follows:

1. J.R. Dudley Construction

Oswego, NY

The bid contains: bid bond was present, addendum number 1 was acknowledged, and the non-inclusive certification. Their proposed bid for the project is lump sum of \$249,100.00, with an additional \$10,000.00 contingency allowance, for a grand total all lump sums of \$259,100.00.

2. Blue Heron Construction

9293 Bonta Bridge Rd

Jordan, NY

The bid contains: addendum number 1 acknowledge, bid bond was present, and the non-inclusive certification. Their proposed bid is a lump sum of \$270,611.00, with an additional \$10,000.00 contingency allowance, for a grand total all lump sums of \$280,611.00.

3. Henderson Brothers Contracting Incorporated

47 Gildner Rd.

Central Square, NY

The bid contains: addendum number 1 acknowledge, bid bond was present, and the non-inclusive certification. Their proposed bid is a lump sum of \$248,191.00, with an additional \$10,000.00 contingency allowance, for a grand total all lump sums of \$258,191.00.

4. C.O. Falter Construction Corporation

403 West Bear St.

Syracuse, NY

The bid contains: addendum number 1 acknowledge, bid bond was present, and the non-inclusive certification. Their proposed bid is a lump sum of \$288,101.00, with an additional \$10,000.00 contingency allowance, for a grand total all lump sums of \$298,101.00.

The reading of the bids ended at 2:10PM. Dudley and Hendersons Brothers have worked on the plant in the past and there weren't complaints then. A reminder that the bids will be discussed on Wednesday January 8, 2025, and that Bill Davis will be in attendance.
